Instructions outline

- [a] The survey aims to collect additional information from community members chosen by PMU
- [b] The respondents were chosen from 11 areas
- [c] In each area, PMU selected 5 respondents
- [d] The total number of CS interviews is $11 \times 5 = 54$ questionnaires
The list with the names of the 55 respondents chosen is provided in advance to Sistemas
- [f] Each respondent is given a unique id code composed by the area (01 to 11) plus the respondent number in the area (1 to 5)
- [g] The 9 areas for the CS operation have the following codes:
 - 01 Boroko
 - 02 Pari
 - 03 Hanuabada
 - 04 Gordons/Erima
 - 05 North Waigani/
Tokarara
 - 06 Morata
 - 07 Gerehu
 - 08 Hohola/June Valley
 - 09 Baruni

- [2] *There must be exactly 5 questionnaires per area, and 54 questionnaires in total*
- [3] *The entry job will be launched ONLY after receiving the total expected questionnaires*
